Who We Are

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- The Jean Tweed Centre provides services for substance use, mental health and problem gambling to women aged 16 and over and their families. The Centre is a **leader** in the provision of best practices and is nationally recognized for the services it provides our community.
- Our treatment programs include Residential & Day programs, Outpatient programs, Pregnant & Parenting programs, Family support, a Continuing Care program, Trauma counseling, a Therapeutic Child Daycare Centre and Supportive housing.
- Our intensive three-week residential program at Cumberland House provides support to 234 women each year. The residence is a place of serenity to many women temporarily providing a **safe** and **supportive** place to call home.
- During the healing process, many client family members also seek **support** within our Family program. The Centre provides direction and support for mothers and expecting mothers, addressing the serious issues and consequences surrounding substance use. The Centre is committed to early intervention and provides **therapeutic services to young children**, including childcare.
